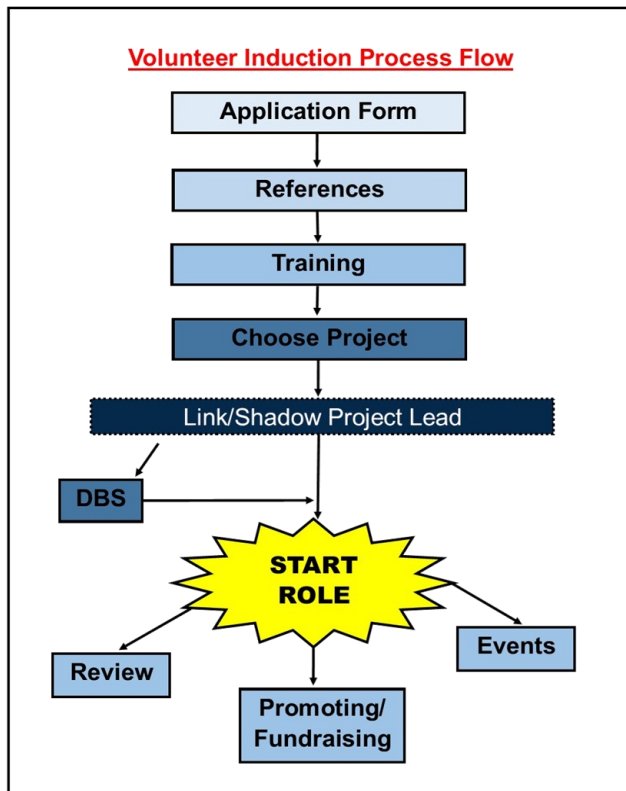
Faithworks' Commitment to you
