- Promote a welcoming environment and treat everybody equally, fairly and with respect
- Respect people's views, interests and uniqueness
- Be reliable and committed to undertaking your role
- Give your time willingly and participate in any training required for your role
- Comply with agreed standards and processes, especially those relating to confidentiality, Health & Safety, safeguarding & problem solving
- Represent Faithworks in a professional and trustworthy way
- Not show or tolerate disrespectful behaviour, bullying, harassment or discrimination in any form
- Talk, in the first instance, to your project leader if you have a problem
- Ensure you have a valid and relevant driving licence, and comply with the highway code and all laws relating to road use where your role involves driving
- Ensure your vehicle is legally compliant, with appropriate business or volunteer insurance, where you use your own vehicle for volunteering purposes
